Language Courses

In order to offer you a wider range of possibilities, you are free to choose a course from the program of "Deutschkurse bei der Universität München e.V.", a language school specialized on teaching students, doctoral students and scientists.

"Deutschkurse bei der Universität München e.V." offers courses at all levels. Absolute beginners should opt for the A1 course "Survival German". This course is designed for PhD students and scholars with **no previous knowledge of German** who wish to acquire basic knowledge of German language for everyday and academic life.

The **Academic German** courses meet the needs of PhD students and scholars, who require **German for scientific studies**. In order to enrol in these courses students must have completed at least the A2 level of German language proficiency or equivalent.

More advanced students of medicine or law with at least a C1 level of proficiency, can improve their language skills by enriching their vocabulary with legal or medical terminology. „Deutschkurs für Studierende der Rechtswissenschaften“ (B1/B2) and „Deutschkurs für Studierende der Medizin“ (C1) are a good preparation for those who wish to do research in German. These courses are only offered in the winter semester.

The course fees for all courses are 80 Euros for participants of the doc.international program.
